



# Professional Development Schedule

## Dyslexia

[Idaho Code 33-1811](#) Section 4a and 4b requires teachers in grades K-12 to receive professional development “not later than the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.” \* The State Department of Education is providing access to professional development meeting this requirement through three separate, 50-minute virtual synchronous training courses.

Attendance at all three sessions will meet the requirements (Idaho Code 33-1811, Section 4a-4b) for K-5 teachers.

- Attendees are not required to attend all three sessions “in a row.”
- You may “mix and match” training dates.

Attendees must register individually for each session.
