#### **Accommodations**

#### Is audio embedded in the test?

A: No. A student has to use a screen reader for the text-to-speech accommodation. Please make sure to use the screen reader specific branching profile. Please contact us if you prefer to use the audio CD format.

# Do I need to purchase a screen reader for the text-to-speech accommodation?

A: Yes. A screen reader would need to be purchased by the school. NVDA is a free screen reader available at https://www.nvaccess.org/download/.

## Can a sign language interpreter be used?

A: Yes. Types of accommodations are to be discussed and decided by the IEP team.

## Logistics

#### How long does each subject test take?

A: The sections are untimed; however, one subject test takes 35 - 45 mins on average.

## Can a student save and finish a testing session later?

A: Yes. A student has 14 days to finish an open testing session.

#### How many units do I need for one test?
