Announcing ACCUPLACER'S New Learning Resources



Overview

Learning Resources is a **free** tool that provides hundreds of learning exercises to help strengthen students' knowledge and gives teachers an increased ability to enhance student learning. Upon completion of ACCUPLACER[®] testing, students are assigned Learning Locator[™] codes that will deliver specific materials targeted to the growth areas identified on their Individual Score Reports (ISR). Educators can review Learning Resources and use the convenient Assignment Sheet feature to create collections of material **individualized** for their students, including their own uploaded resources.

How to Use Learning Resources

Begin by collaborating and brainstorming with key stakeholders at your institution. Think of ways you could use Learning Resources to complement your institution's programs and enhance the learning experience for your students. Some possible ideas include:

- Summer Bridge Programs
- Test Prep Sessions
- Remediation Prior to Retesting
- Corequisite Resource Tool

Next, think about the operational step. Consider giving teachers and faculty ACCUPLACER Site Reporter access so they can develop plans to share student results via the following reports:

- Score Roster Report
- Placement Roster Report
- Custom Report

You can try out the <u>Learning Resources</u> for yourself using the pass phrase ACCU_edu when creating your account. Reviewing the <u>Perspective User Guide</u> is a great way to gain insight.
