

## ACCUPLACER Placement Test Decision-Making Process

## **DECISION-MAKING PROCESS (ACCESSIBLE)**

- 1. Student with disabilities who is not on an IEP is expected to participate in SAT/ACT without accommodations to meet the college entrance exam graduation requirement.
- 2. Student with disabilities who is eligible for the Idaho Alternate Assessment is exempt from the college entrance exam graduation requirement.
- 3. For student with disabilities who is on an IEP, the IEP team should review the structure, timing, and setting of SAT/ACT.
  - If the student can meaningfully participate in SAT/ACT without accommodations, the student is expected to participate in SAT/ACT without accommodations.
  - If the student can meaningfully participate in SAT/ACT with accommodations, the student is expected to participate in SAT/ACT with accommodations.
- 4. If student with disabilities who is on an IEP cannot meaningfully participate in SAT/ACT, the IEP team should review the structure, timing, and setting of ACCUPLACER.
  - If the student can meaningfully participate in ACCUPLACER without accommodations, the student is expected to participate in ACCUPLACER without accommodations.
  - If the student can meaningfully participate in ACCUPLACER with accommodations, the student is expected to participate in ACCUPLACER with accommodations.
