WIDA Screener Training and Certification



Training & Certification Requirements WIDA Suite of Assessments



- Yearly training and certification is required prior to all WIDA
 Screener and WIDA Screener for Kindergarten administrations
 - Training and certification is completed in the <u>WIDA Secure Portal</u>
 - Training and certification is only required for the specific WIDA Screener the Test Administrator is responsible for proctoring
 - Certification quizzes must be completed with a score of 80% or higher to attain certification
 - A record of all TA certifications should be printed and kept on-site

WIDA Screener Test Security



Test Security, Validity & Reliability



• IDAPA Rule 08.03.02.111.11

- Test security is of the utmost importance. To ensure integrity of secure test items and protect validity and reliability of test outcomes, test security must be maintained.
- School districts will employ security measures in protecting statewide assessment materials from compromise.
- Each individual who has any opportunity to see test items must sign a state-provided confidentiality agreement, which the district must keep on file in the district for at least two (2) years.

Test Security and Integrity Maintaining Test Security



- Screener materials including electronic and printed materials are considered secure
 - Store materials in a secure area
 - Materials accessed via the WIDA Secure Portal are considered secure
 - Inventory the materials before and after a screener session
 - Only use screener(s) materials to identify a student for services
 - Do not share test items with others
 - Report any test incidents within 24 hours
 - Idaho SDE Test Incident Log
 - Securely store or destroy student response booklets after use

 - Second semester KG and first semester grade one complete all domains

- WIDA Screener Online (second semester grades 1 12)
 - Second semester grade one complete all domains

- WIDA Screener Paper (second semester grades 1 12)*
 - *WIDA Screener Paper may be used as an administrative consideration

Test Form Selection



- Students in the first semester of their first year in a new grade-level cluster (K, 1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, 9-12), are administered the lower grade cluster screener form
- Selection of appropriate test form table (Grades 1 − 12)






WIDA Screener Setup & Administration Reminders



- When possible have a familiar adult screen the student
- Testing environment should be welcoming and free from distractions
 - Place a "Testing in Progress" sign on the door
- Practice tests, test demos, and sample items are available to prepare students prior to screening
- Test Administrator should be comfortable with administering the different components
 - WIDA Screener for KG practicing with a colleague is advisable



Administration sequence





- Test Administrator Script guides the sequencing of each section
 - Read the **bolded** text and possible additional prompts when necessary
 - Task increase in difficulty targeting the WIDA English language proficiency levels 1-5
- Test Administrator scores each test item or task immediately after the student gives a response
- Test Administrator inputs the student's scores into the <u>WIDA</u>
 <u>Screener for Kindergarten Score Calculator</u>






- Scoring Sheet
 - MOVE ON & STOP IF indicate when to continue giving the student more challenging prompts within a section of the screener and when to go on
 - Follow these rules carefully

WIDA Screener for Kindergarten Administration Dos/Don'ts & Best Practices



• Dos

- Prepare materials before the test administration
- Know your test materials well and practice with the script and test materials prior to testing

• Don'ts

- Never repeat the listening prompts
- Sound out words in the Reading section
- Use Screener test items outside the testing environment

Best Practices

- Avoid testing during recess, lunch, or snack times.
- Offer a bathroom break before testing, and reassure students that they'll be back in their classrooms in time for critical activities.
- Offer stretch breaks as needed to help students refocus.
- Use the scripted questions and phrasing to present the test tasks




- The district's Central Office Services (network configuration) must be updated and operational
- Test registrations are prepared and setup in WIDA Assessment Management System (WIDA AMS)
 - Using WIDA AMS for WIDA Screener Online Video Tutorial
- Student test tickets must be printed prior to testing
- Prepare/Print student Writing response booklet (grades 1-3)
- Prepare headsets/headphone for use during screener



- TA monitors student progress
 - Ensure each student completes and exits each domain
- Grades 1-3 Writing Domain
 - TA reviews Writing tier placement presented on the student's screen after the Listening and Reading domains have been completed T
 - TA reads WIDA Screener Online Grades 1 & 2-3 Writing Test Administration Script





Screener Scoring Inter-Rater Reliability




- To increase inter-rater reliability of scores, it is recommended that only a few district personnel score WIDA Screener Online / Paper student Speaking / Writing responses
- Test administrators giving WIDA Screener for Kindergarten are encouraged to practice reading the administrator scripts and using the print material with a colleague prior to administering the screener

Reporting WIDA Screener Scores English Learner Management System



- Enter WIDA Screener scores into ELMS
 - Select the appropriate "Test Type"
 - WIDA Screener Online "WIDA Online"
 - WIDA Screener for KG "WIDA KG"
 - WIDA Screener Paper "WIDA Paper"
 - HLS is required to be uploaded into ELMS at the time the screener scores are entered
 - Ensure to save and submit the information
- Place a copy of the WIDA Screener scores into the child's cumulative file
