**SDE kicks off Legislative Roadshow in North Idaho this week**

(BOISE) – Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra and key staff members will launch their annual Legislative Roadshow in North Idaho Wednesday and Thursday, April 24-25, to share the latest Idaho education developments with area superintendents, charter school administrators, business managers and other district and school representatives.

Reporters and photographers are welcome to attend all or part of the daylong sessions.

The presentations begin in Coeur d’Alene Wednesday in the Lake Coeur d’Alene Room in the Student Union Building at North Idaho College. Also on Wednesday, Superintendent Ybarra will visit Rathdrum’s Garwood Elementary, a national Blue Ribbon School for 2018. That visit is scheduled for approximately 10:30 a.m.
