SDE's Legislative Roadshow to sweep southern Idaho, livestream statewide

(BOISE) – Superintendent of Public Instruction Sherri Ybarra and key staff members will meet with educators in Boise, Twin Falls and Idaho Falls next week to discuss the legislative session and the latest Idaho education developments.
