Great new tool for residency verifications – 3 year-olds

An idea from the fall training has been added to the "All Student Details" report and the "Student Services" report. There is now a column called **EOP Age** (End of Period Age). This is the age that the child will be at the end of the performance period or 8/31/17. This column can be filtered to show only 3 year olds... That way you can put the **Date of Birth** column next to the **EOP Age** column and NOT do a residency verification before the 3rd birthday. Thanks Robert Gomez for the great idea!

Two rural liaisons meet and recruit door-to-door in a local housing area where migrant families are known to live. Since this only benefits one district, a week later, they meet again and visit a dairy in the other liaison's district and talk to the farmer, and with his permission, employees on break. Both liaisons bring business cards, flyers, and posters. Because they are super smart, they invite their regional to accompany them.

Working together is key to providing real opportunities that one person alone would not pursue, either out of nervousness or inexperience. It also enhances safety for both liaisons. When we work together, everyone wins – most importantly migrant families and children win!
