Attaining English Proficiency - 2022 & 2023



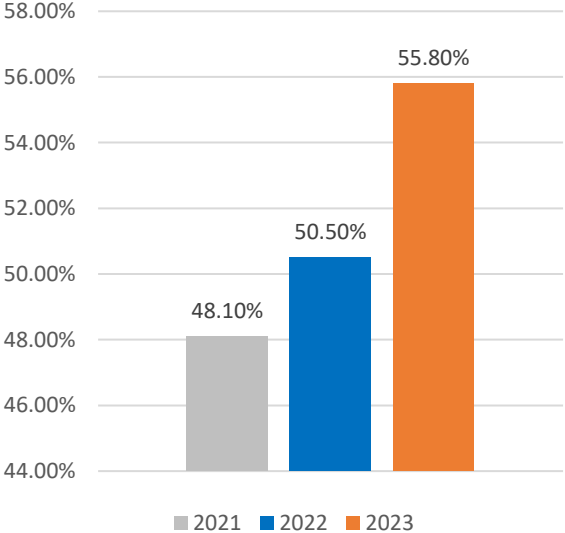

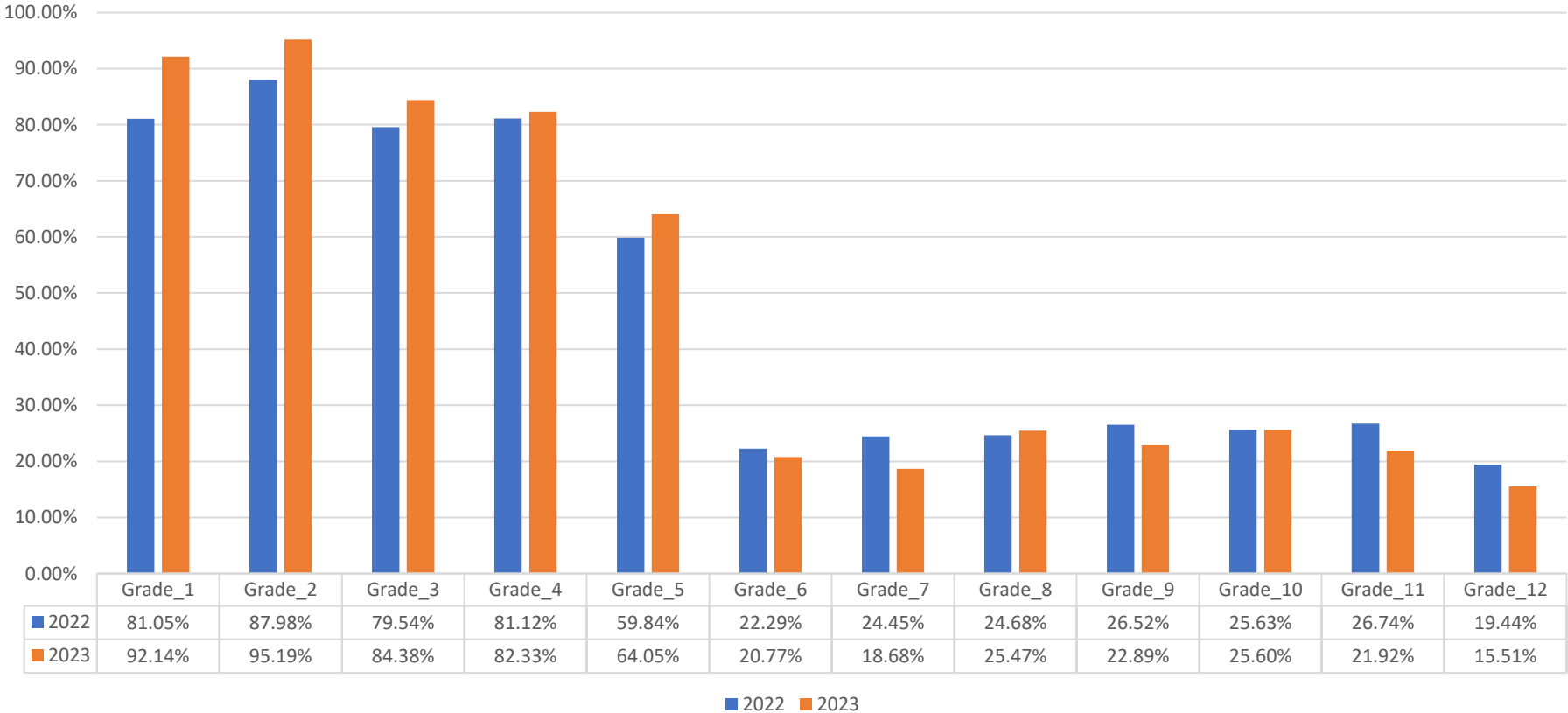

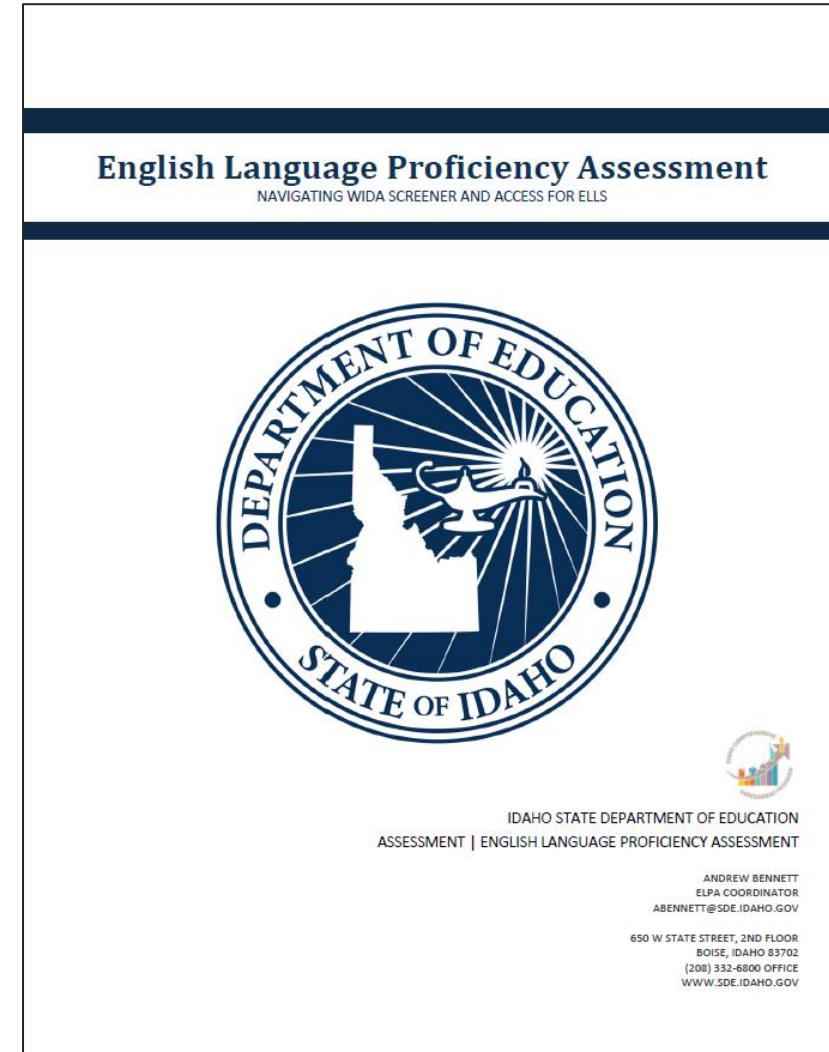

Language Functions and Associated Language Features

Create conjecture using definitions, patterns, and rules through...

- Relating verbs (*have, belong to, be*) to make a claim (*9/15 is equivalent to 3/5 and 6/10 is an equivalent fraction too because they are all multiples*)
- Adverbial phrases (*for qualities, quantities, frequency*) to add precision related to conjecture
- (*The interior angles of a triangle will always add up to 180°*)*

Generalize commonalities and differences across cases through...

- Conditional clauses (*when, if*) to extend conjecture (*If you remember the inverse operations, you can figure out the missing quantity by...*)
- Declarative statements to present generalizable processes (*The divisibility rules can help you find all the factor pairs of a product.*)

Justify conclusion with patterns or rules through...

- Conditional structures (*if/then, when*) to demonstrate conclusions (*Adding 3 to an even number always gives you an odd number and if you add 3 to an odd number, you will get an even number.*)

Training & Certification Requirements



- **Yearly training and certification is required prior to all WIDA Screeners & ACCESS for ELLs administrations**
 - Training and certification is completed in the [WIDA Secure Portal](#)
 - Training and certification is only required for the specific assessment the Test Administrator intends to proctor
 - Certification quizzes must be completed with a score of 80% or higher to attain certification
 - A record of all TA certifications should be printed and kept on site by the School Coordinator and Test Administrator

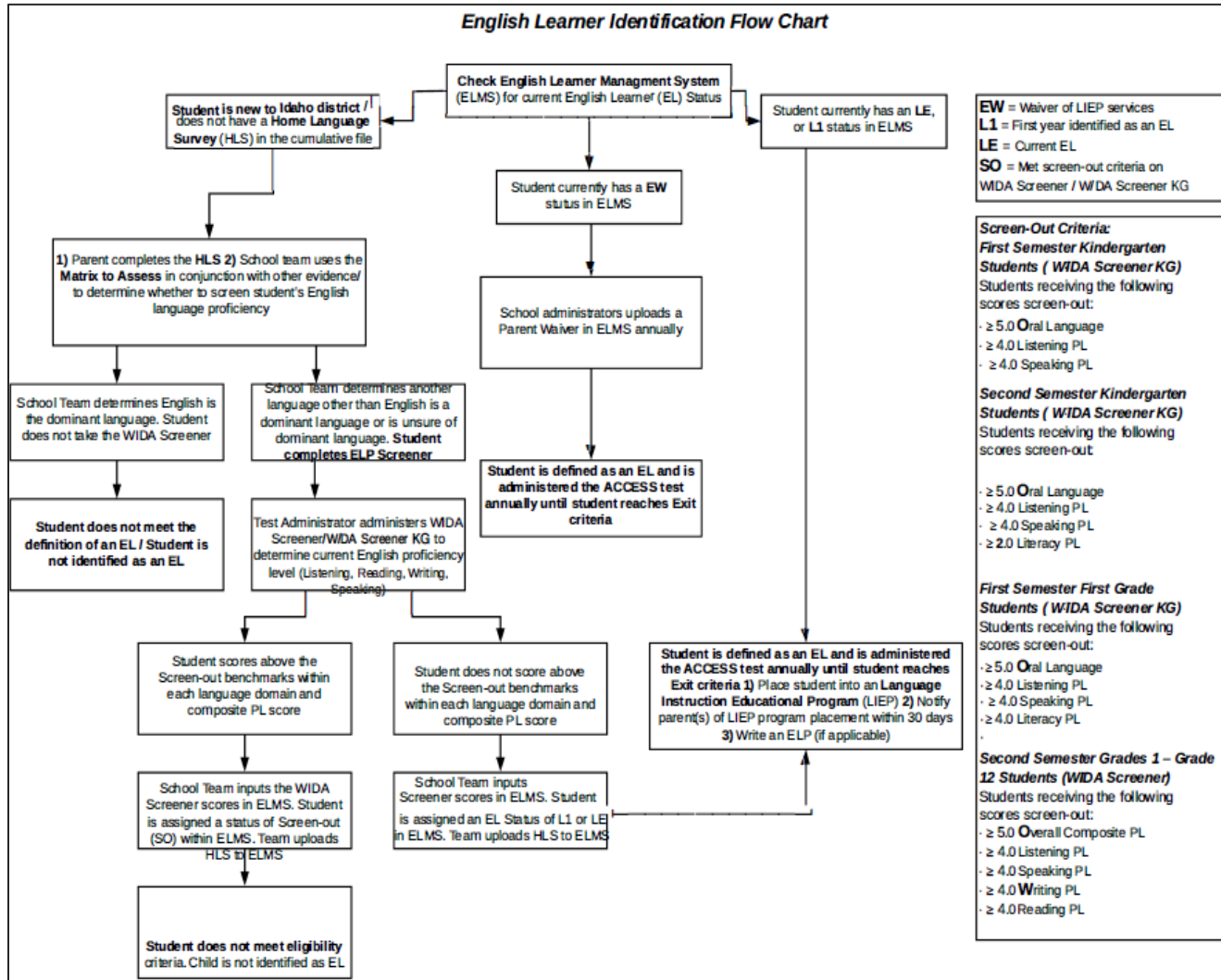

1. Review child's enrollment information / Review Home Language Survey parent responses
2. Review English Learner Management System
3. Determine whether to administer an English language proficiency (ELP) screener
4. Administer ELP screener
5. Score and document ELP screener results
6. Record ELP screener results
7. Communicate outcomes with parents
8. Provide LIEP services consistent with the *Castañeda v. Pickard* ruling

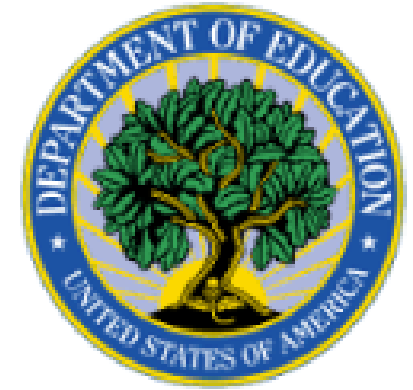

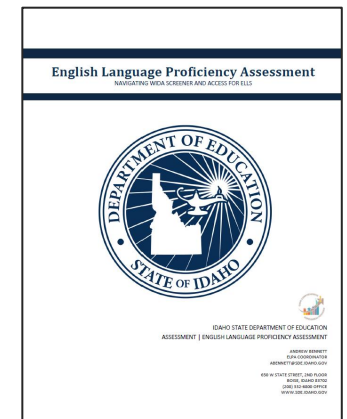

- Districts are asked to verify/modify ACCESS for ELLs mode of administration & assign accommodations

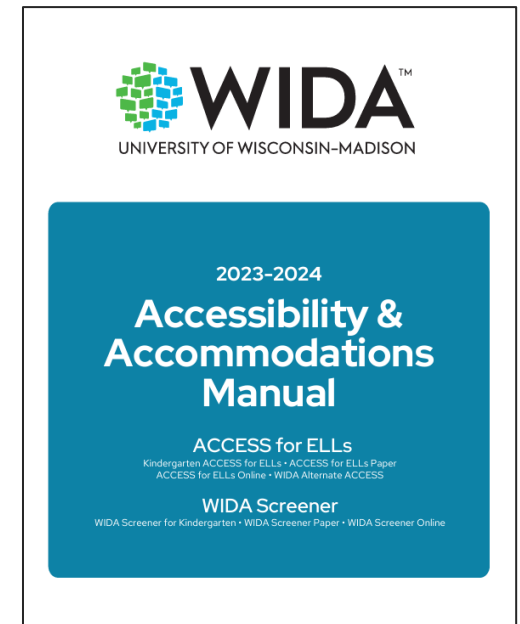

 - Save boxes, district and school pre-ID labels, shipping labels
 - Track secure test materials using the security barcodes
- **Date:** January 12 – 17, 2024
- **Platform:** Manual – Locally controlled process

ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

Before Testing - Accessibility and Accommodations



- Understand the available supports and accommodations on the various ACCESS for ELLs test versions
 - Students are required to have an IEP or 504 Plan to receive an accommodation
 - Students should be familiar with and receive supports and accommodations during regular instruction



ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

During Testing – Participation



- ESSA Section 1111[b][2][G] – Assessments of English Language Proficiency
- IDAPA Rule 08.02.03.111.04 – Testing Population
 - All students in Idaho public schools, grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12), are required to participate in the comprehensive assessment program approved by the State Board of Education.
- Participation Expectation
 - All English learners with an **L1**, **LE**, or **EW** status are required to take **all** domains of ACCESS for ELLs
 - Students who meet the Idaho Alternate Assessment Participation Criteria may complete Alternate ACCESS for ELLs

ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

During Testing – Test Incident Log



- Test incidents (interruptions, improprieties, irregularities, or test security violations) must be logged within the SDE's Test Incident Log
 - Reference the [Assessment Integrity Guide](#) for definitions of different test incidents and the process to address each
 - The Test Incident Log may be accessed via the [ELPA webpage](#) or by logging into the ISEE web application



ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

During Testing – Tracking Progress



- Track the completion of ACCESS for ELLs Online in WIDA AMS under Status Reports
 - Daily Cumulative Student Status Report
 - Daily Student Status Report
 - Weekly District Report
 - Daily District Report of Testing Status of Testing Status by School
- Test sessions should not remain open more than a day

ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

During Testing



- ACCESS for ELLs test material should remain secure
 - DTCs inventory, disseminate, and track test materials
 - SCs and TAs should follow district check-out/check-in procedure
 - Security checklist – Inventory List
 - Test material needs to be securely stored when not in use



ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

After Testing – Returning Test Materials



- District sends ACCESS for ELLs test materials back to DRC
 - **Purpose:** Account for secure test materials and to match written responses to online responses
 - **Date: March 15, 2024**
- **Late Returns may result in a delay of student performance scores**

ELPA Cycle 2023-2024

After Testing – Data Validation & ACCESS Appeals



- **LEA Pre Data Validation**

- **Purpose:** identify student demographic, accommodation, and test result records that could potentially contain errors. The process provides the opportunity for districts to correct possible errors before reporting ACCESS for ELLs student performance
- **Date:** March 29, 2024 – April 4, 2024
- **Platform:** WIDA AMS

- **ACCESS Participation Rate Appeals**

- **Purpose:** provides districts the opportunity to adjust a district's English learner ACCESS participation rate. This may be achieved by submitting an appeal to have a student added to, or removed from the participation calculation
- **Date:** End of May 24, 2024 – June 7, 2024
- **Platform:** Idaho System for Educational Excellence (ISEE)
