CSI UP plans / CSI Grad plan



- Needs Assessment focus on the current reality, not the future, don't answer every question, if an area doesn't fit — N/A
- Goals Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Rigorous, & Time bound
 - Increase graduation rate by 10% ⁽²⁾
 - Increase graduation rate from 58% to 75% for the 2023-24 SY ©
- Strategies to support the goal
- Budget (CSI UP) no shirts, no rewards, no incentives
- Monitoring of the goals








The New...

 - 35 CSI Grad schools 23% out of compliance
- ATSI if identified for 3 consecutive years, you are identified as CSI UP beginning in the next cohort
