The ideal candidate will possess strong leadership, communication and interpersonal skills in working with teens and the ability to adapt to a variety of settings and situations.

Responsibilities:

- Organize and implement educational and recreational activities
- Lead program activities in large and small group settings
- Counsel and mentor high school student during the day for 10 days to foster self-esteem and self-confidence
- Contribute and participate in a variety of tasks related to program activities
- Mentor, supervise, and encourage junior counselors
- Participate in a 1-day staff development workshop prior to the Institute
- Encourage students to use Institute acquired skills to reach out and assist others through peer coaching.
- Provide opportunities for students to participate in leadership experiences and shared decision making
- Exemplify positive and appropriate behavior at all times
