Section 4: Charter Schools and Dual Enrollment of the Special Education Manual states, "Special education services (specially designed instruction and services calculated to meet the unique needs of a student with a disability) shall be the obligation of the public charter school."

It makes sense for special education services to be the responsibility of the school providing the academic content. If, for example, a student has IEP goals in the area of Math and that student is taking Math at the brick & mortar school, it does not make sense for the public charter school to be responsible for the student's special services in the area of math.

It is better for the student and makes more sense if this part of the manual read something like this, "Special education services (specially designed instruction and services calculated to meet the unique needs of a student with a disability) shall be the obligation of the school supporting the area(s) of instruction related to the student's IEP goals."
