REVIEWING PLANS USING REQUIRED CRITERIA

The Department's criteria for State plans are identified in the statute under Section 5233 [20 U.S.C. 7351 b] While the statute reflects what needs to be included in a State application, States are free to organize their plans in ways that respond to their own needs, and ways to best implement the program. At a minimum, however, the State plan must include all the stated elements below.
