

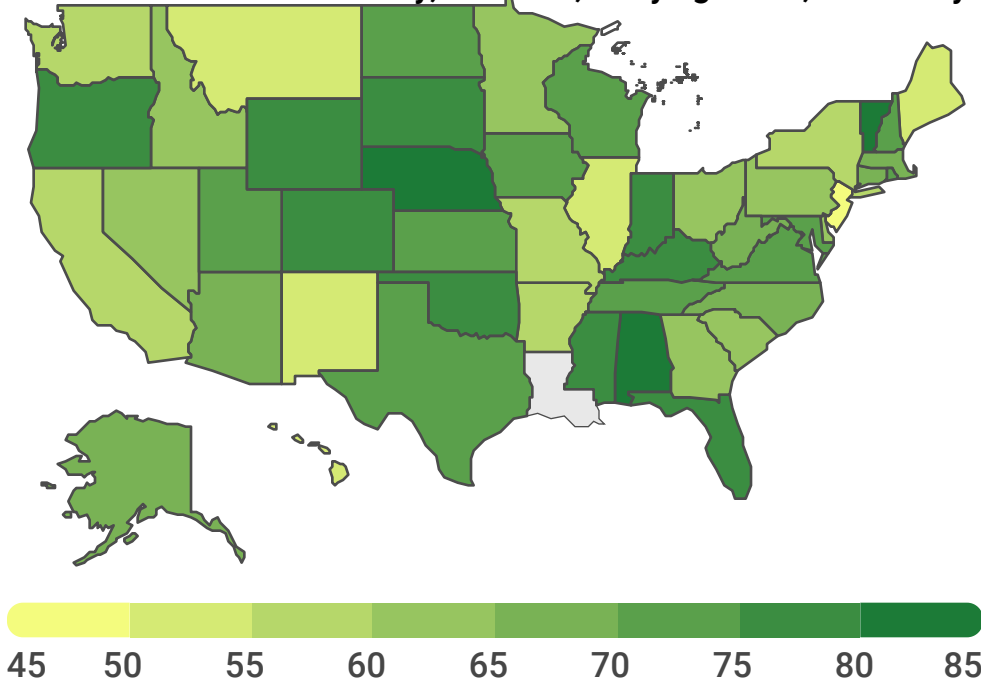


## OSEP Fast Facts: Educational Environments of Children with Disabilities, Ages 5 (in kindergarten) through 21, Served under IDEA Part B

### Percentage of Students with Disabilities, Ages 5 through 21, Receiving Services Inside a Regular Class 80% or More of the Day, in the US, Outlying Areas, and Freely Associated States: SY 2020-21



In SY 2020-21, 66.17% of all school aged children, served under IDEA, Part B, received services inside a regular class 80% or more of the day.

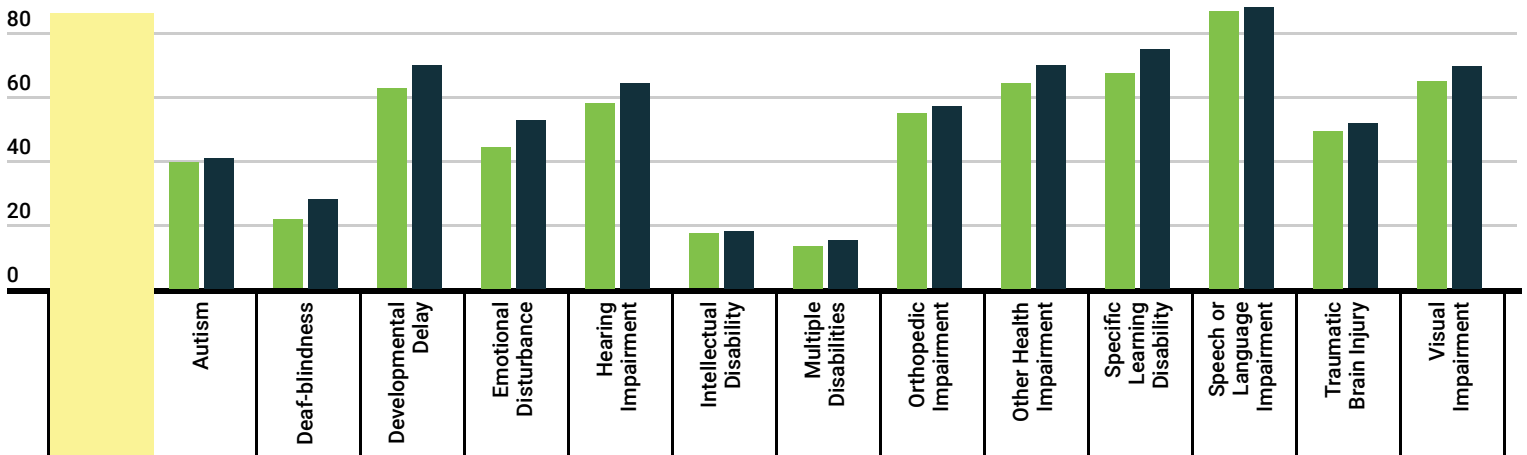

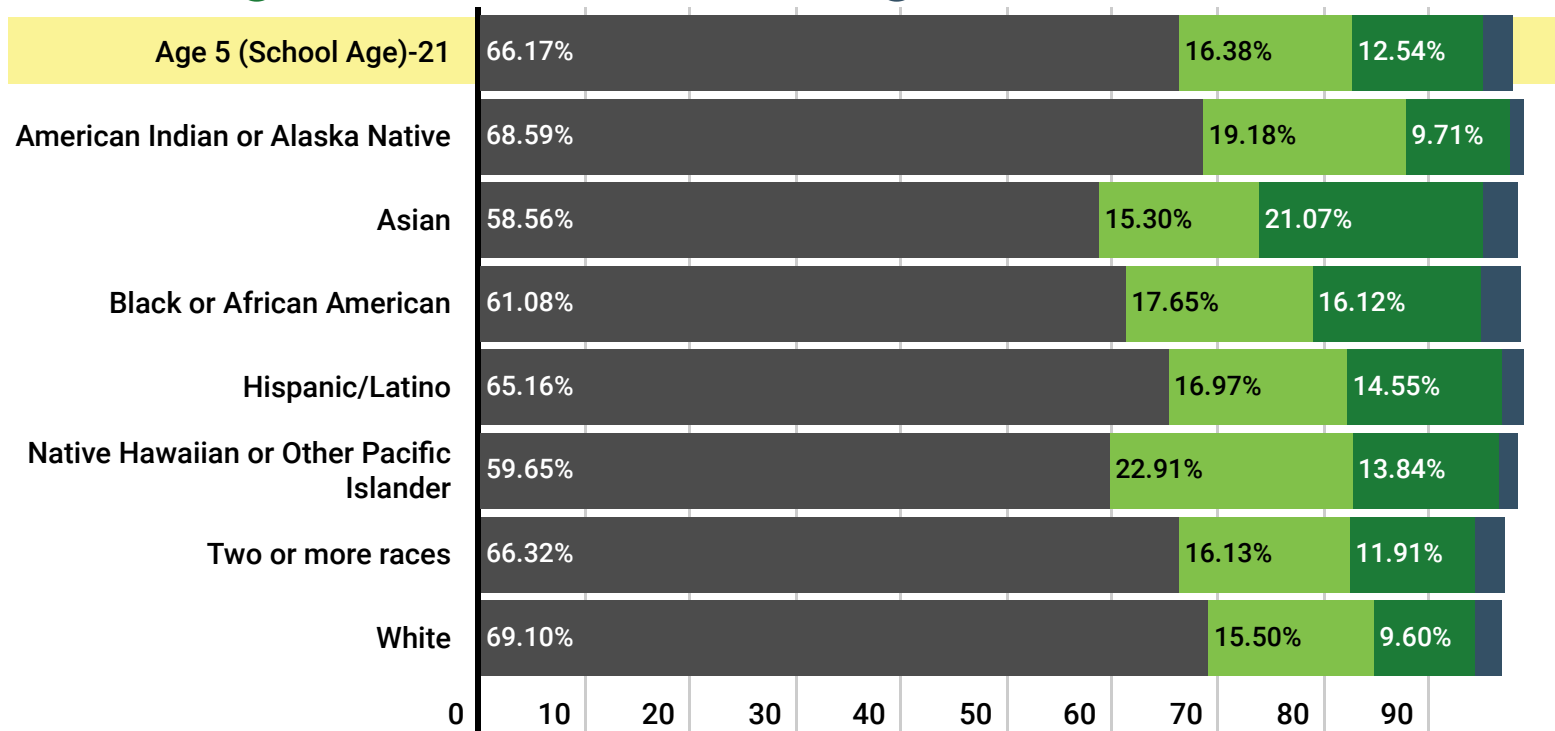

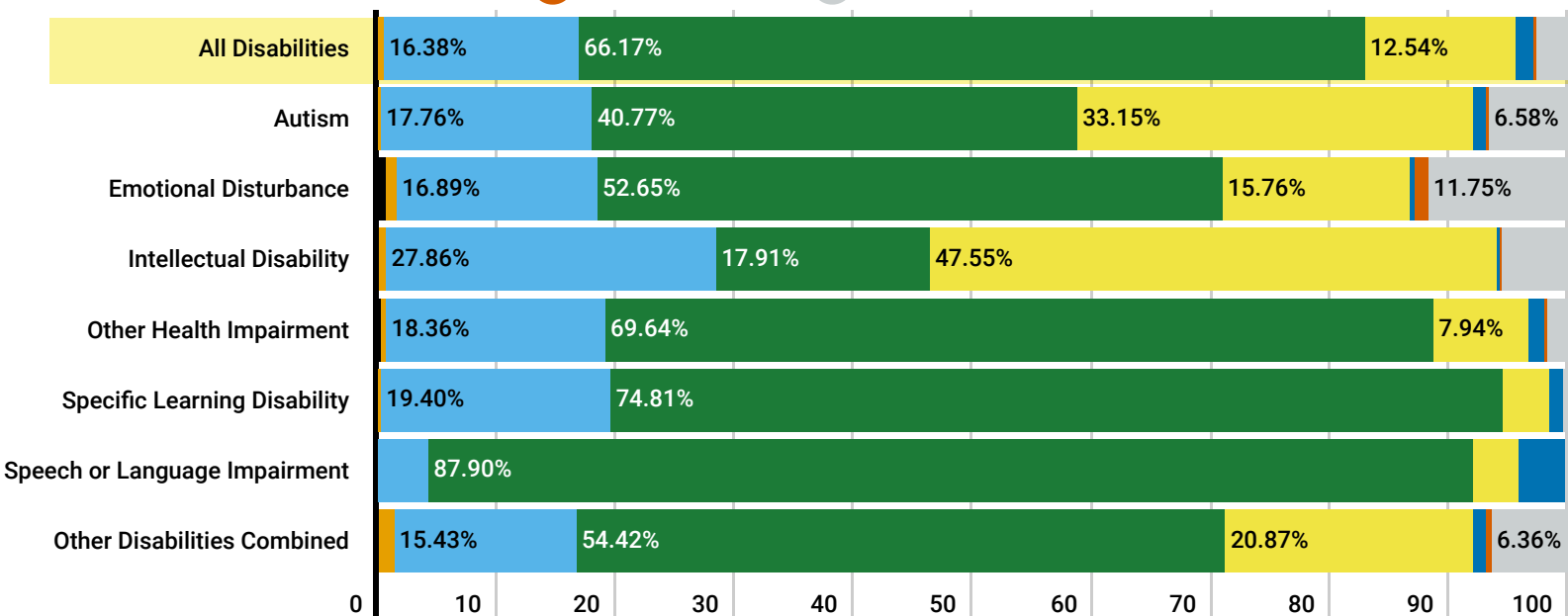

All SY 2020 data for students ages 5 through 21 represents students ages 5 (in kindergarten) through 21.

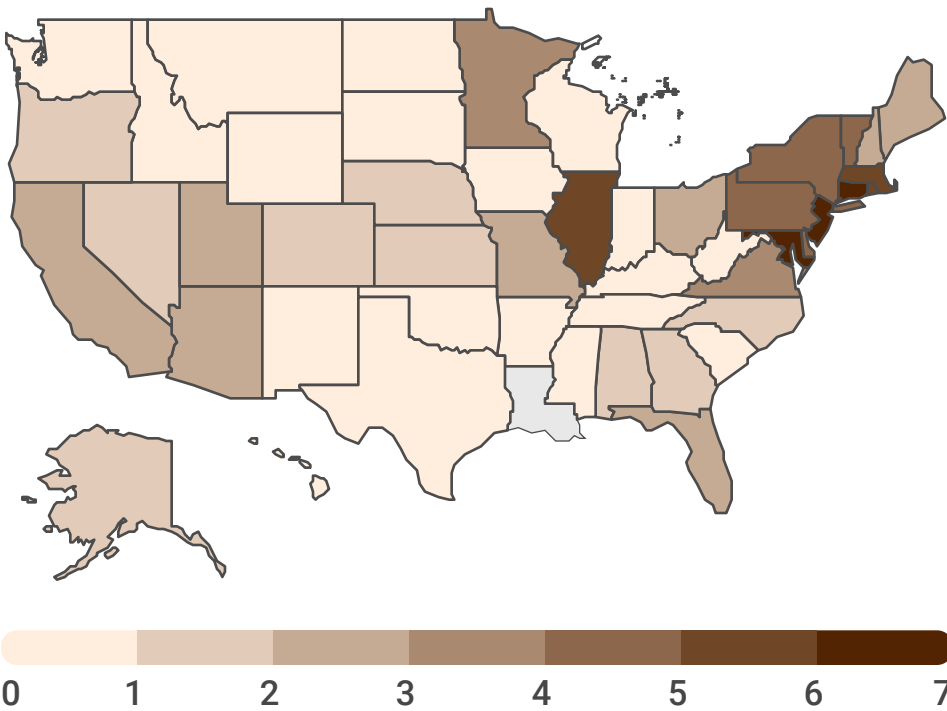
# Percentage of Students with Disabilities, Ages 5 through 21, Served in Separate Schools, in the US, Outlying Areas, and Freely Associated States: SY 2020-21

In SY 2020-21, 2.64% of all school aged children ages 5-21 served under IDEA, Part B, received services in a separate school.

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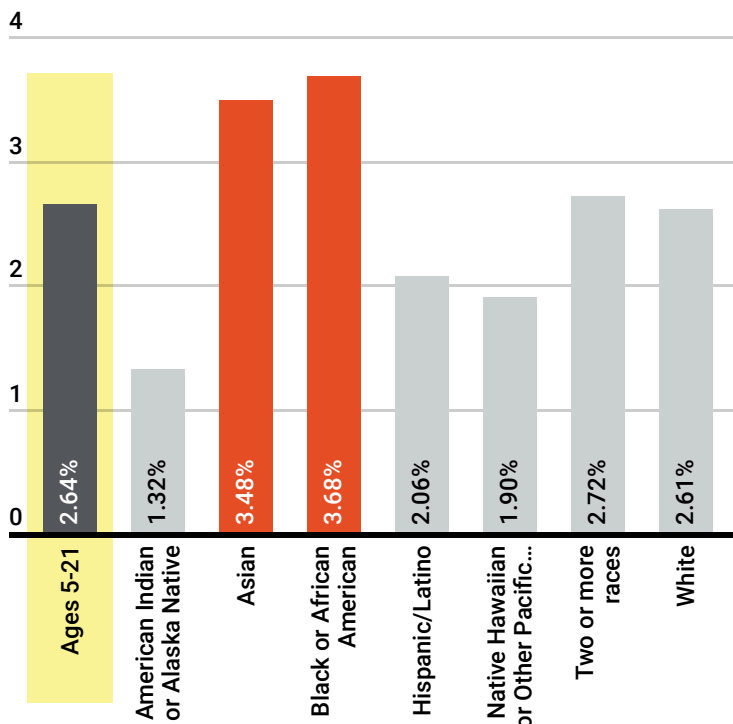

## Percentage of Students with Disabilities, Served in Separate Schools, by Race / Ethnicity in SY 2020-21.

Black (3.68%) and Asian (3.48%) students with disabilities are more likely to receive services in separate schools than all students with disabilities (2.64%).

## Percentage of Black or African American Students with Disabilities, Served in Separate Schools in SY 2020-21

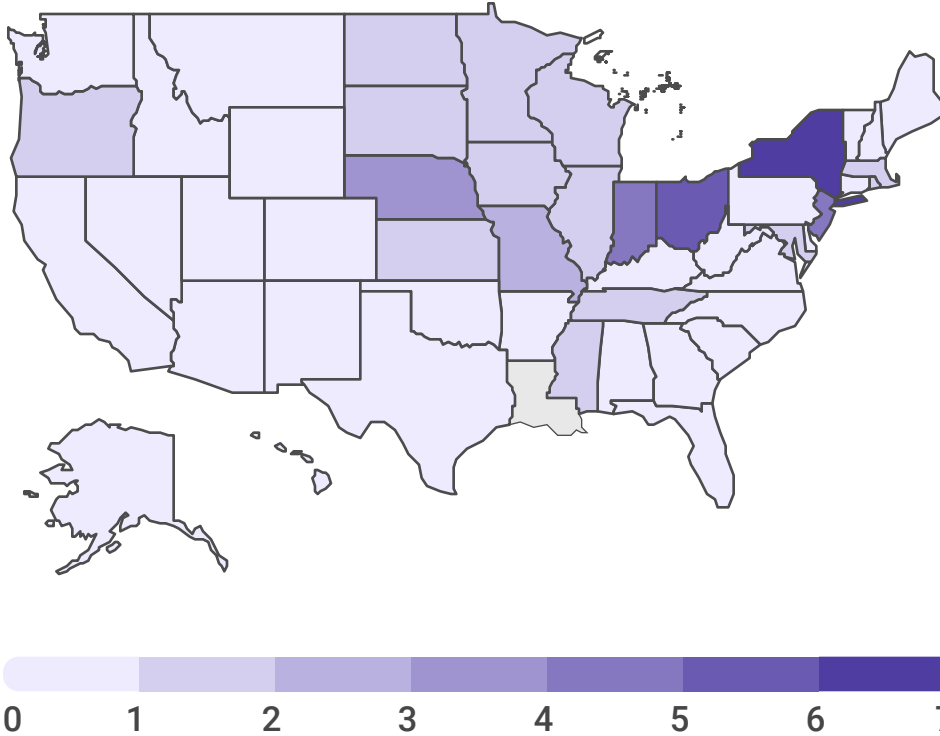

In SY 2020-21, 1.65% of all school aged children ages 5-21 served under IDEA, Part B, received services in parentally placed private schools.

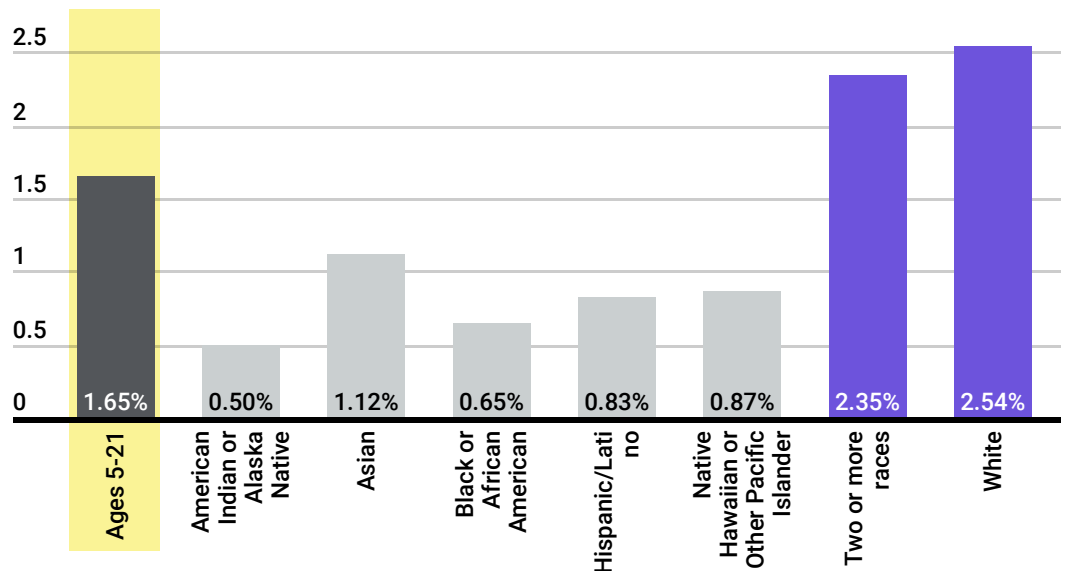

## Percentage of Students with Disabilities, Ages 5 through 21, Served in Parentally Placed Private Schools, By Race/Ethnicity in the US, Outlying Areas, and Freely Associated States: SY 2020-21

Students who are two or more races (2.35%) and White (2.54%) students with disabilities are more likely to receive services in parentally placed private schools than all students with disabilities (1.65%).
