

Constitution DaySeptember 17, 2024

PURPOSE

Discuss the Constitution and its value with all Idaho students.

STEPS

Pre-Lesson:

- 1. Review slide deck and videos prior to sharing with students.
- 2. Select the appropriate grade-level slide deck for your students.
 - Edit the standards that apply to your grade level/course on Slide 2
- 3. Review extension activities located on Slide 6

Lesson:

- 1. Share with students that September 17 is Constitution Day in the United States.
- 2. Play the Idaho Department of Education's video describing the Constitution and its meaning to various leaders in Idaho.
 - a. Full-Length Video (2 min 15 sec)

- c. <u>Importance of the Constitution</u> (32 sec)
- 3. Share the learning targets and the essential question with your students.
- 4. Watch the linked video on Slide 4 to help your students answer the EQ.
- 5. Ask students the discussion questions on Slide 5; help students use both videos to help answer the questions and share their own ideas.
