Deadline to submit pre-identification or bulk registration file.	9/19/19 final date to submit to receive labels by 10/2/19)	 Each district upload student information using our bulk registration tool to simplify the process on test day. Access the tool using your College Board account at: Bulk Registration Tool PSAT points of contact often coordinate with district test coordinators when submitting the bulk registration file.
Pre-admin/non- secure materials arrive in schools	9/19/19	 Schools providing bulk registration files no later than 9/19/19 will receive labels, answer sheets, and testing manuals by 10/2/19 If the school did not submit a bulk registration file your answer sheets and testing manuals will arrive with your test materials.
Secure test material arrives in schools	10/9/19	Once testing materials arrive, check the contents of the shipment immediately to ensure you have the materials required for test day.
Test Day	10/16/19	Alternate test date 10/30/19
Return answer sheets for scoring	10/17/19	Return all answer sheets for scoring. You may now begin the remittance process. More detailed information will be provided at a later date.

Scores available to Students	Mid-December	Scores available online through the College Board Student Reporting Portal at: <u>Student Scores Home</u>
