# English Learner Participation in State Assessments

# Participation in State Assessments



# Three Options

- **Option 1:** EL take State assessments **without** accommodations.
- **Option 2:** EL take State assessments **with** accommodations.
- **Option 3:** EL qualifies for WIDA Alternate ACCESS.
  - Student meets the Idaho Alternate Assessment Participation Criteria

## **Participation Criteria**

# WIDA Alternate ACCESS Participation Criteria

English learners must meet all four IDAA Participation Criteria.

1. The student has a significant cognitive impairment.
2. The student is receiving academic instruction that is aligned with the Idaho Extended Content Standards.
3. The student's course of study is primarily adaptive skills oriented typically not measured by state or district assessments.
4. The student requires extensive, direct, individualized instruction and substantial supports to achieve measurable gains in the grade- and age-appropriate curriculum.

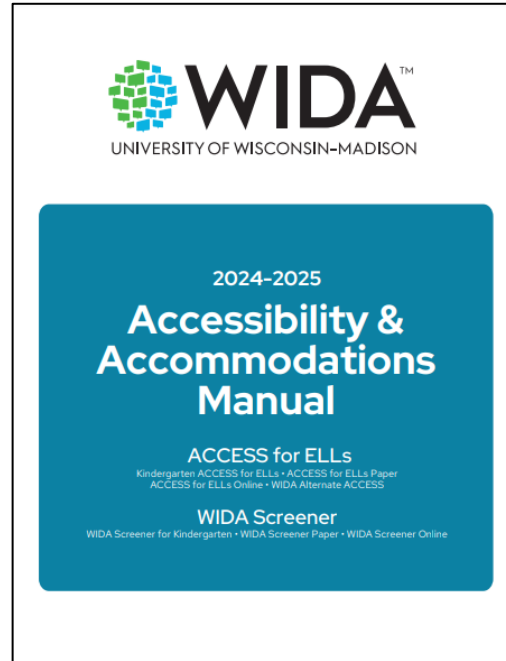

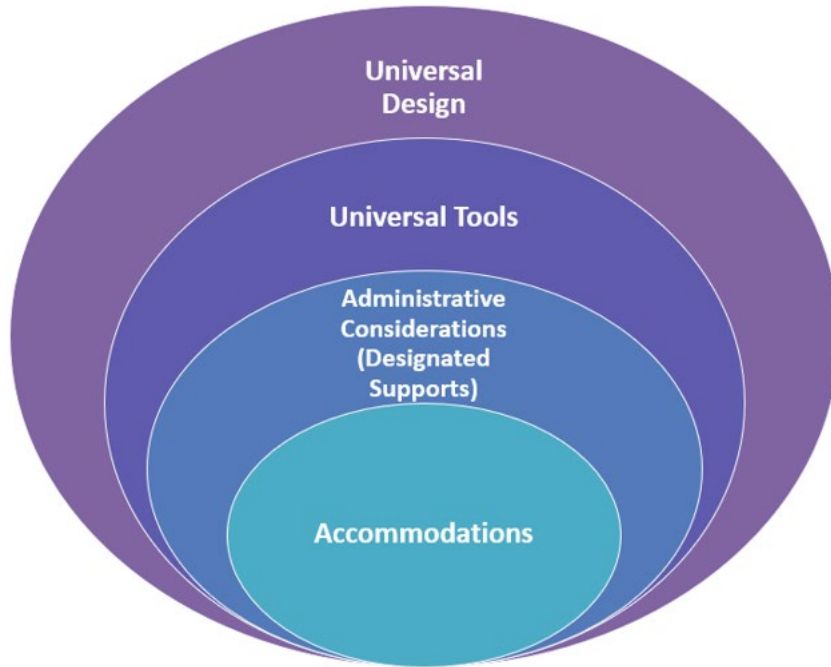

# WIDA Accessibility Features



**Universal Design:** Inherent in test design; ensure fair and inclusive assessments. Ex. non-biased items, clear directions, clearly defined constructs.

**Universal Tools:** Available to all students based on student preference and selection. Ex. breaks, highlighter, line reader, scratch paper, etc.

**Administrative Considerations/Designated Supports:** Available to any student for whom the need is identified by educator or educational team, including parent/guardian and student. Ex. color contrast, magnification, masking, simplified or translated test directions, etc.

**Accommodations:** Require IEP or 504 Plan accommodations. Ex. American Sign Language, Braille, speech-to-text, etc.

# WIDA Accessibility Features Delivery Method

## Embedded Features

Features available through DRC INSIGHT

- Sticky Notes
- Magnification
- Amplification

## Non-Embedded Features

Features available outside DRC INSIGHT

- Color contrast sheets
- Translated Test Directions
- Line Guide

**The decision to use embedded or non-embedded features should reflect the student's prior use of, and experience with, both embedded and non-embedded universal tools, designated supports, and accommodations.**

# WIDA Accessibility Features

## Universal Tools

### Audio Aids

- Amplification devices
- Noise buffers
- White noise machines

### Color Adjustments

- Transparent color overlays
- Color contrast

### Highlighters

- Colored pencils
- Crayons

### Keyboard Navigation

### Line Guide or Tracking Tool

- Notecards
- Bookmarks
- Sentence highlighter strips

### Low-vision Aids or Magnification Devices

### Scratch Paper and Sticky Notes

- Considered secure test material

# WIDA Accessibility Features

## Administrative Considerations

### Test Timing and Scheduling

- Supervised Breaks
- Short Segments
- Extended Testing Time (school day)

### Test Environment

- Adaptive and Specialized Equipment or Furniture
- Alternative Microphone
- Familiar Test Administrator
- Individual or Small Group Setting
- Specific Seating

### Test Content Presentation

- Test Format (Paper / Online)
- Redirection
- Encouragement
- Read Aloud to Self

### Test Item Responses

- Monitor Placement of Responses

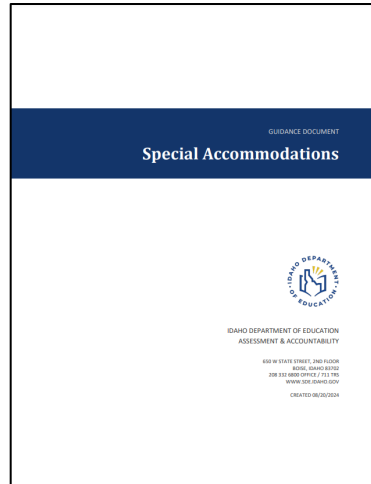
# WIDA Accessibility Features Accommodations

- In-person human reader (IR)
- Repeat in-person human reader (RP)
- Extended Speaking (ES) test response time
- Extended testing of a test domain over multiple days (EM)
- Interpreter signs test directions in ASL (SD)
- Large Print (LP)
- Manual control of Item audio (MC)
- Repeat Item Audio (RA)
- Scribe (SR)
- Student responds using a recording device, which is played back and transcribed by the student (RD)
- Test administered in a non-school setting (NS)
- Word processor or similar keyboarding device to respond to test items (WD)
- Braille (BR)

# WIDA Accessibility & Accommodations Special Accommodations Guidance & Requests

## Temporary Accommodation

- Emergence of a disability that is the result of a temporary condition.
  - Broken Arm
  - Inpatient Care
  - Concussion



## Non-Standard Accommodation

- Emergence of a disability that is the result of a temporary condition.
  - Religious / Cultural Belief
  - Family Member Providing Medial Care

# WIDA Accessibility Features Reminders

- Accessibility features and accommodations shall be familiar to the student and used during regular instruction
- The assignment of a support or accommodation is a team decision
- Designated supports are available to all students and require a documented need
- Accommodations are only available to students who have an Individual Education Program (IEP) or 504 Plan
- Students can familiarize themselves with accessibility features by being exposed to practice tests
- Alternate Assessments (IDAA/WIDA Alternate ACCESS) are only given to student who meet the Alternate Assessment Participation Criteria



# Domain Testing Exemption

# Domain Testing Exemption



**When all appropriate accommodations have been offered and the student's disability remains a barrier to assessing a language domain, the student may be eligible for a domain(s) exemption.**

**ACCESS Appeal Required: District Test Coordinators must submit an ACCESS Appeal (late May - early June)**

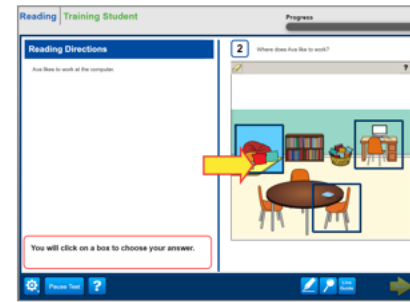
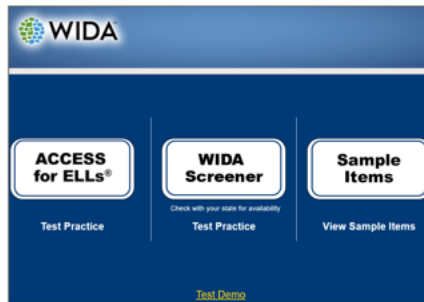
- Appeal evidence must justify why the student was unable to participate
- Evidence of IEP or 504 Plan
  - Example: Student who is Deaf Hard of Hearing may not be able to meaningfully participate in the Listening and Speaking domains.

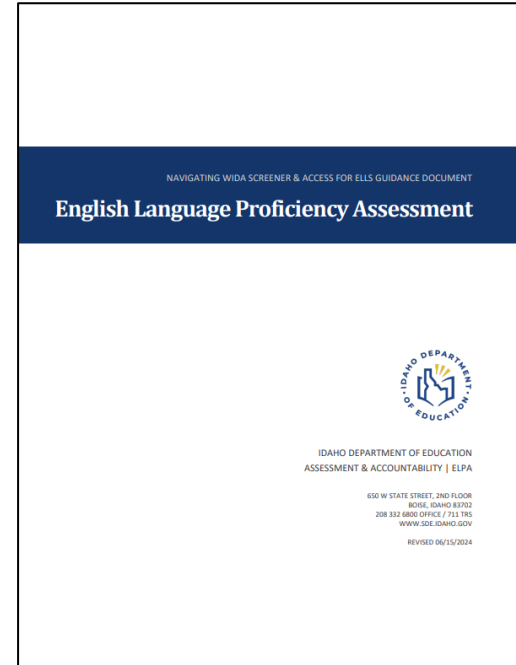
