



## **In-Person WIDA Screening Considerations for 2020-21**

The following considerations may be used when screening students in-person using the Kindergarten WIDA ACCESS Placement Test (K W-APT) and/ or the WIDA Screener (Paper / Online) in grades 1-12. Trained Test Administrators may use this document in conjunction with specific district level and local health department guidance to heighten hygienic practices during an in-person English language proficiency screening. Below you will find ideas and potential solutions that Test Administrators may find helpful when assessing students.
