BACKGROUND

The Professional Standards Commission received an allegation of unethical conduct concerning Matthew Paul Fisher. Following an investigation, the Executive Committee of the Professional Standards Commission reviewed the information before it and determined that probable cause exists for initiating an administrative action against Matthew Paul Fisher's certificate. The Executive Committee has recommended the following Stipulation.

STIPULATION

- 1. This is an agreement (Stipulation) between Matthew Paul Fisher (Mr. Fisher) and the Executive Committee of the Professional Standards Commission (the Commission).
- 2. If Mr. Fisher wishes to agree to this Stipulation, he must sign and return this stipulation and any attachments to the Commission by 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time) on August 30, 2024, unless he has been granted an extension.
- 3. After Mr. Fisher and the Executive Committee agree to and sign this Stipulation, the Stipulation must be approved by the Commission, and the Commission must enter the attached consent order before this Stipulation resolves the matter.

A. STIPULATED FACTS AND LAW

5. The Commission regulates educator certification in Idaho.

6. Mr. Fisher holds the following certificate and endorsement issued under the

authority of the Idaho State Board of Education:

Standard Instructional Certificate endorsed All Subjects (K-8), effective a.

June 7, 2022, through August 31, 2025.

7. On information and belief, Mr. Fisher voluntarily entered into a settlement

agreement and agreed to permanently surrender his teacher certificate in Iowa.

8. Upon information and belief, Mr. Fisher's Iowa license surrender was based upon

allegations that he sent inappropriate emails to students that were personal in nature and exceeded

the acceptable boundaries of teacher-student communications.

9. The Executive Committee determined that probable cause exists for initiating an

administrative action against Mr. Fisher for violating the following laws and rules governing

educator certification:

a. Mr. Fisher's conduct or course of conduct described in paragraphs 7-8 willfully

violated a principle of the code of ethics that was adopted by the Idaho State

Board of education. Idaho Code § 33-1208(1) ("Willful violation of any

professional code or standard of ethics or conduct, adopted by the state board

of education."). Specifically, Mr. Fisher violated Code of Ethics Principle II

Idaho Admin Code r. 08.02.02.076.03 ("A professional educator maintains a

professional relationship with all students both inside and outside the physical

and virtual classroom.").

STIPULATION – 2

10. Mr. Fisher admits that he violated the laws and rules cited in paragraph 9 and acknowledges that there is sufficient evidence to support a finding of a violation of the laws and rules cited in paragraph 9.

B. STIPULATED DISCIPLINE

- 11. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, the following discipline will be imposed by the Commission on Mr. Fisher's certificate:
 - a. That Mr. Fisher's certificate be revoked.
 - b. Any costs associated with Mr. Fisher's compliance with the terms of this Stipulation are his responsibility.
- 12. During the pendency of this Stipulation Mr. Fisher will comply with all laws and rules governing educator certification in Idaho.

C. PRESENTATION OF THIS STIPULATION

- 13. Once Mr. Fisher signs this Stipulation and timely returns it to the Commission, and the Executive Committee signs this Stipulation, the Deputy Attorney General assigned to the Commission will present this Stipulation to the Commission at the Commission's next business meeting.
 - 14. The Commission may accept, reject, or modify the Stipulation.
- 15. If the Commission modifies this Stipulation, it must receive Mr. Fisher's approval on any modification before the Stipulation is effective.

D. WAIVER OF RIGHTS

- 16. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, Mr. Fisher knowingly: intelligently, and voluntarily waives the following rights:
 - a. the right to a hearing;

- b. the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses;
- c. the right to present evidence or to call witnesses, or to testify at a hearing;
- 17. If this Stipulation is approved by the Commission, the Commission may impose discipline upon Mr. Fisher's certificate without further process.
- 18. By signing this Stipulation, Mr. Fisher agrees to waive any requirement for a hearing under Idaho Code§ 33-1209(3) to be conducted within 90 days of a request for a hearing. This waiver applies to any hearing request made before the Commission ultimately rejects this Stipulation (if it does) or before Mr. Fisher ultimately rejects a modified stipulation (if Mr. Fisher does). If the Commission ultimately rejects this Stipulation or if Mr. Fisher ultimately rejects a modified stipulation, and Mr. Fisher has requested a hearing, the 90-day hearing timeframe will begin from the ultimate rejection.

E. GENERAL ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

- 19. This Stipulation contains the entire agreement between the parties, and Mr. Fisher is not relying on any other agreement or representation, whether verbal or written.
- 20. This Stipulation, if approved by the Commission, or modified and approved, resolves a contested case. If approved, the Stipulation, consent order, and any attachment are public records. And if approved, the Commission may make available through its or the State Department of Education's website a copy of the Stipulation, consent order, and any attachment: and may report any discipline to the national clearinghouse for teacher certification.
- 21. Mr. Fisher agrees that he has read this Stipulation, has had the opportunity to discuss it with legal counsel, if he so chose, and understands that by signing below, he will be agreeing to the terms of this Stipulation.
