## **ROAD SHOW KICKS OFF ON MAY 24<sup>TH</sup> TO DISCUSS NEW RESOURCES FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER ADVISING**

(BOISE) – The Advanced Opportunities Support Team will be hosting an event in each region of Idaho to provide updates to school personnel on Advanced Opportunities and new resources for college and career advising.

The Advanced Opportunities Roadshow will feature updates and changes for the various Advanced Opportunities based on an exciting streamlining of the programs. Specific to the expansion of the Fast Forward program, participants will learn what to anticipate for next school year and how schools and districts can prepare for changes over the summer.

The training will also include a deep dive into:

- House Bill 458 (Fast Forward),
- House Bill 477 (Postsecondary Credit Scholarship), and
- Senate Bill 1290 (College and Career Readiness Advising).

Additionally, the team will provide information regarding updates to the Fast Forward portal. This event is recommended for all stakeholders including superintendents, school administrators, counselors, dual credit coordinators, business managers, and career development personnel, in addition to parents and students. At this event, the SDE will provide opportunities for participants to provide constructive feedback regarding any areas of improvement from the field.
