Title V-B Program



It is the purpose of this program to address the unique needs of rural school districts that frequently—

- 1. Lack the personnel and resources needed to compete effectively for Federal competitive grants; and
- 2. Receive formula grant allocations in amounts too small to be effective in meeting their intended purposes.

• SEC. 5202. [20 U.S.C. 7341a] PURPOSE.

Rural Schools


Definition:

- Fewer than 20 enrolled students per square mile within district boundaries
- County has less than 25,000 residents based on most recent census (2010)

Public charter may be considered rural if district meets the definition of a rural district.

An LEA may not serve those "full virtual" schools with its REAP funds.

A full virtual school is defined by NCES as a school with no physical building where students meet with each other or with teachers and all instruction is virtual. These schools are not included when determining an LEA's REAP eligibility and award amount. The SRSA and RLIS grant programs were created to address the unique capacity and resource access challenges faced by schools and LEAs serving students who reside in rural and remote communities. Because "full virtual" schools serve students regardless of the residence of their students, they are excluded from the ADA count.




