

Purpose



The purpose of Title I, Part D (under Title I-A) is to:

- Improve educational services for children and youth who are neglected (N), delinquent (D) or At-Risk so that they have the opportunity to meet challenging State academic content and achievement standards;
- Provide children and youth who are N or D services so that they can successfully transition from institutionalization to further education or employment; and
- Prevent youth from dropping out of school and provide youth who have dropped out and youth returning from correctional facilities with a support system to ensure their continued education.



REMEMBER: We are guided by Idaho's Consolidated Plan goals:

- All Idaho students persevere in life and are ready for college and careers;
- All education stakeholders in Idaho are mutually responsible for accountability and student progress;
- Idaho attracts and retains great teachers and leaders.

Clarity will be a process: Definitions – Processes/Systems – Tools – Training – Support/Monitoring

Allowable Use of Title I-A At-Risk/Neg. Set-Aside



Funds may be used for:

- Instructional supports
 - Tutoring/Interventions
 - Curriculum
- Non-instruction costs
 - Behavior supports
 - Counseling & prevention support
 - Mentoring programs
 - Attendance programs

Clarification for Neglected Set-Aside Description



- District/Community Day Program
 - Personnel
 - Academic supports
 - Behavioral Supports
 - Graduation Supports
 - Substance Abuse Supports
- Title I-A type programing in Neglected Institution

(partnership – plan of support)

- Instructional Support
- Curriculum


- LEAs shall reserve such funds as are necessary to provide services comparable to those provided to children in district Title I schools to serve children in local institutions for neglected children
- If appropriate, Title I, Part A funds shall also be reserved to serve children in local institutions for delinquent children, and neglected or delinquent children in community day programs.

Title I-A: At-Risk/Neglected Set-Aside | 10

(ESSA sections 1113[c][3][A][ii] and [B][i-ii]).

NOTE: The Title I, Part A neglected reservation should not be confused with the Title I, Part D Neglected or Delinquent or the At-Risk program. Title I, Part D funds are allocated by the Idaho Department of Education) primarily to support State and County juvenile corrections/detention education programs.



- 2 reported #s for a "Neglected" site.






Neglected Set Aside is pre-populated. This set-aside is additional funding to districts who have a qualifying "Neglected" residential facility within their geographical boundaries AND have participated in the fall annual count process.

These funds will need to be included in the Title IA budget and briefly described in the NEW "Neglected" Tab.

If you are aware of residential facilities located within your district geographical boundaries, please contact Suzanne to determine if they may qualify as an Neglected, Delinquent, or At-Risk "counting" site.




Important! The "Budgeted" amount must equal the "Set-Aside". The Budgeted amount is the total amount of the "District Program" budget and the "Facilities" budget.




