- · CSI UP
 - Bottom 5% of schools

- · TSI
 - Bottom 5% in each subgroup
- ATSI
 - Bottom 5% of TSI schools per subgroup

How?



Factors for CSI Grad

- Graduation Rate <67%
 - 5-year cohort
 - · 3-year average

When?



- Cohort 2: 2022-2025 last year of the cohort!! ☺
 - CSI UP & CSI Grad schools will not change
 - New list of TSI/ATSI coming soon
- Cohort 3: 2025-2028
 - New Identification cycle will be identified using data from 2024-25, 2023-24, and 2022-23
 - CSI UP 3 year identification, funding available if receiving Title I-A funds
 - CSI Grad 3 year identification, no funding
 - TSI / ATSI 1 year identifications, no funding

CSI UP plan / CSI Grad plan / TSI-ATSI plan



- Needs Assessment focus on the current reality, don't answer every question, if an area doesn't fit – N/A
- Goals Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Rigorous, & Time bound
 - Increase graduation rate by 10% 8
 - Increase graduation rate from 58% to 75% for the 2023-24 SY - ☺
- Strategies to support the goal
- Budget (CSI UP) no shirts, no rewards, no incentives
- Monitoring of the goals

Exiting

CSI UP

- Perform ABOVE the lowest 5% of same-type schools
- Perform ABOVE the 10%ile on ISAT in <u>both</u> ELA & Math

CSI Grad

Achieve ABOVE 67%
 graduation rate for 2
 consecutive years –OR achieve an average
 ABOVE 67% graduation
 rate across 3 years

TSI / ATSI

- Perform ABOVE the lowest 5% per subgroup
- Perform ABOVE the 10%ile on ISAT in <u>both</u> ELA & Math for the subgroup identified
