- Dual Credit Courses
- Exams
- Certifications
- Licensures

ADVANCED OPPORTUNITIES

Advanced Opportunities is a nationally recognized program of student choice, student empowerment and provides funds for students to meet their post-high school goals for career preparedness.



EXAMS

Students can use Advanced Opportunities funds to cover the full cost of the following exams:

- Advanced Placement (AP)
- College Level Examination Program (CLEP)
- International Baccalaureate (IB)
- Professional Certifications



DUAL CREDIT TUITION

Dual credit courses are college courses that earn both high school and college credit. Through the Advanced Opportunities program, students can request up to \$75 per credit for college courses. Most college course taught at the high school by an Idaho college are \$75 per credit, making most courses nearly free.
