




## What Do I need to create my student account?

ADVANCED

OPPORTUNITIES

- Computer/internet access
- Personal email account
- Name of your school district
- Name of the school you are currently attending



### **Create Your Student Account**



- Go to Advanced Opportunities
   Portal website:
   https://advancedops.sde.idaho.gov/
- 2. Choose "Create Account"
  - Fill out all required information and select "Enroll New Student"
- Check email you provided and look for email from "No Reply" and click on "Verify".

#### **Important:**

OPPORTUNITIES

- You are creating an account you will use during your high school and possibly college years.
- Do not guess your birth year and only use your <u>formal legal name</u>.
- Remember your LOGIN information and store it in a secure document.
- Use a personal email account (not school issued email).

## **Participation Form**



- Participation form must be signed by both the student and parent/guardian.
- 2. Return signed form to your school Advanced Opportunities staff. *Do not send form to the Idaho Department of Education.*




## **School Approval**



 Once the student account has been created and verified, the school will need to approve and grant access.





## Requesting AO Funding



Make an appointment with your Advanced Opportunities staff prior to requesting funding for courses. Courses and exams should be part of your overall career pathway plan.

- Visit the Advanced Opportunities <u>portal</u>.
- Select <u>"Login"</u> and then select "Request Funding"
- Speak with your Advanced Opportunities staff with any questions you may have.



#### **Required Information:**

- Name of the <u>county</u> you live in, **not** where your school is located.
- EDUID # your Advanced
   Opportunities staff can give you this information.
- If you do not see your course choice, notify your school AO staff. They may need to load the course into your school options. Do not create your own names for courses.

## **View Funding Information**



#### **Access Account Details:**

- 1. Visit the Advanced Opportunities portal.
- 2. Select <u>"Login"</u>
- 3. Select "Course Submissions" or "Exam Submissions"
- 4. Select "Funding Details"

## The Early Graduation Scholarship



Available only to public school students who graduate from high school at least one year early.

#### **Requirements:**

- Must graduate at least one year early. Summer counts as the beginning of the school year.
- Apply within 2 years of graduating
- Scholarship can only be used at any Idaho public postsecondary institution.

**\$2,400** per year

#### To apply:

- Log into Advanced Opportunities portal.
- Select "Apply for Early Graduation Scholarship"
