






Funding & Providers

The graph further shows the percentage of dual credit paid provider type in FY23.




Student Participation Trends


The largest number of funding request through the Student Opportunities Assistance Program were for dual credit courses. Dual credit courses composed 77% of the total number of funding requests paid.


