Idaho driving test now covers bikes, pedestrians

It's only two questions out of 40, but advocates for bicycle and pedestrian safety in Idaho see it as a real victory for raising awareness of the rules of the road (and sidewalk) for everyone in transit — not just motorists. Do You Know Idaho's Bicycle Laws? This is one of 40 questions Idaho bicycle laws on the DMV website.

Q: A bicyclist may make a left-hand turn onto a one-way highway on a red light:

- a) After slowing and yielding to other traffic
- b) Only after the light changes to green
- c) After stopping and yielding to other traffic

100 to Zero Summer Driving Mobilizations

Summer is traditionally the worst time for fatal and serious injury crashes on our highways. With summer *fast* approaching Office of Highway Safety is planning the 100 to Zero (previously called 100 Deadliest Days) summer driving mobilizations which will run from Memorial Day to Labor Day 2016. The mobilizations will focus on all areas of traffic safety with priorities for: Speed, Distracted Driving, Impaired Driving and Occupant Safety.
