

INFRACTION PENALTY SCHEDULE

A person charged with infraction shall never be arrested. If the motorist refuses to sign the citation, there is an appropriate place on the uniform citation form for the officer to indicate that he has served the citation on the defendant - just like a civil service of process.

Idaho Infraction Rule 9(b) Fixed Penalty and Costs for Infraction: The entry of a judgment for an infraction under this rule shall order the defendant to pay a dollar amount for a fixed penalty and court costs in the following amounts:
